The wines of Château Boyd-Cantenac result from the terroir revealed by the passionate work of all. Belonging to the same family for four generations, they are recognized as being among the most representative Crus of the Margaux appellation. During aging, for which they have a remarkable aptitude, each vintage affirms its personality and thus becomes a moving witness to the past.

Soil / Terroir: Sandy siliceous gravels, with very little clay and excellent drainage, from the Quaternary Era

Age of the vineyard: 38 years

Harvest : spread out from September 25th to October 12th, 2020

Vinifications : 20 days of maceration in stainless vats

Aging : 80% new French oak barrels for 16 months.

Commentaire de dégustation :

The wine shows an intense, vivid purple color. The nose is fine and complex, revealing beautiful aromas of ripe black fruits and delicately integrated spices, a sign of careful aging. On the palate, it seduces with its suppleness, freshness, and silky texture. The attack is precise, the body generous, and the long, fruity finish reveals racé and harmonious tannins. Already very enjoyable, this Margaux promises excellent development over the coming years, combining elegance and the nobility typical of the appellation.
